Because of no classes on May 28, if above includes Wk1 \$72 ea for full day or \$40ea for half day (this is 20% off of the 1Wk rates). 10% off 2nd student in family, 20% off 3rd student.

This ten week curriculum runs 10 hours per day including 2-4 hours of academic instruction in Math, Science/Social Studies, and Language Arts. It also consists of gymnastics, trampoline, enrichment classes, etc., lunch (for full-day students), and snacks.

Students in the program will receive instruction in both Language Arts and Math in order to prepare for the next school year. The program is topic-based and each week students will be immersed into a new and exciting topic of the week.

(Exceptions will be made for very mature preschoolers with permission from the Summer School Program Head.)

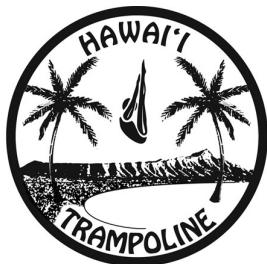

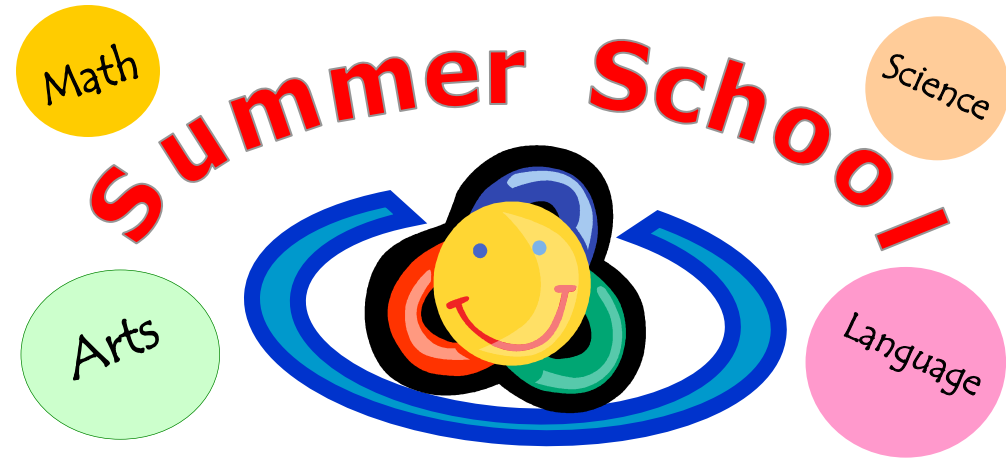

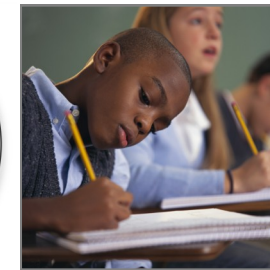

Academic Courses

Active Learning for Little Ones

(Those not having completed the first grade)

Phonics, reading fluency, listening skills, number concepts and operations are the basic ingredients of these classes. (Minimum four years old)

Language Arts *(Students who have completed the first grade)*

Students work in small groups to increase vocabulary and improve writing skills. Innovative, multi-sensory teaching techniques and practice, practice, practice make this fast moving class exciting and effective.

Math

(Students who have completed the first grade)

Students work individually on their own custom-designed projects to meet their unique math goals. Focusing only on the specific skills and concepts insures that students efficiently improve math understanding and performance.



Science/Social Studies

(Students who have completed the first grade)
