

# 2009 Hawaii Trampoline Championships

26-29 March 2009 at Hawaii Academy, 1314 Moonui Street, Honolulu

The 9<sup>th</sup> Hawaii Trampoline Championships were recently conducted at Hawaii Academy in Honolulu. This year there were 117 participants, with four from Canada and 11 from Japan, ranging in age from 3-90 years, including males and females, with ability levels from entering beginners to world-class elites. Hawaii is unique in having a large number of adults and senior citizens participating in this sport. However, many local families missed the event this year because they were off-island traveling during spring break. Following are participants with their scores and places.

### Hawaii Champions Challenge and Overall Grand Champion

At the finals held Saturday night, 28 March 2009, the champions for each level on trampoline and double mini joined the elites to determine the overall rank of champions and the grand champion. All athletes competed according to senior elite (FIG) rules where three execution scores (10.0 maximum each) were added with difficulty scores (0.0-14.0) and total determined the overall rank. Elites were encouraged to do their most difficult routines and were out ranked by lower level athletes if the elites didn't hit their intended routines. All athletes were ranked according to total score and the grand champion (best of the best) was named, regardless of age or ability for males and females on trampoline and double mini-trampoline. The first five places received Hawaii surfboard trophies with ribbons going to those places thereafter. **Nani Vercreuysen** (Hawaii) was crowned the female grand champion for both events. For males the grand champion for trampoline was **Vincent Ng** (Canada) and for double mini was **Ken Goto** (Hawaii).

## Special Award: Most Spectacular Performance



A special award was given to the most spectacular performance in the competition. This year it was an amazing crash in which **Mr Yuma Shimakawa** (24 yrs), a many time Japan National Champion on Double Mini, performed a rudi-out (double front with a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  twist) mounter to a back  $1\frac{3}{4}$  somersault to land on the mounter surface, and then executed a  $\frac{3}{4}$  front to his feet and landed in a stick position on the runway facing away from the double mini. Because he scraped his head on the bed while dismounting the officials applied a large forehead bandaid as his award during the closing of the awards ceremony. Event officials are looking for a video of this maneuver taken from a side view so it can be shared with the trampoline community on You-tube.
