## Four Week Academic Courses 6/11—7/6

### Active Learning for Little Ones

Phonics, reading fluency, listening skills, number concepts and operations are the basic ingredients of these classes. (Minimum four years old)

### Language Arts (Student has to have completed first grade.)

Students work in very small groups to increase vocabulary and improve writing skills. Innovative, multi-sensory teaching techniques and practice, practice, practice make this fast moving class exciting and effective.

### Math (Student must have completed first grade.)

Students work individually on their own custom-designed program to meet their unique math goals. Focusing only on the specific skills and concepts insures that students efficiently improve math understanding and performance.

### Potpourri (Student must have completed first grade.)

This portion will include an array of age-appropriate academic activities! From geography to photography, physics to philosophy and cooking to composition, this highly interactive class offers intellectual stimulation and excitement every day. Important foundational skills are woven throughout every activity to reinforce and enhance the content of our math and language arts curricula.

## 7/9—7/20 Two Week Jump Start Courses

An improved vocabulary enhances reading comprehension, writing skills, and private school and college admissions test scores. During this two week class, students will learn and use useful and impressive language in a variety of writing experiences. Upper level students will practice vocabulary strategies for standardized testing.

Intended to be an intensive math prep, students will work to fill in any gaps in knowledge and to strengthen foundations for a strong start in the coming school year.

Younger Students will be exposed to exciting renditions of classic children's literature. Authors will include Robert Louis Stevenson, C.S. Lewis, Rudyard Kipling and many others. Students will also learn to identify various genres as well as the elements of literature.

Older Students will focus on Shakespeare's Much Ado about Nothing in the form of the abridged for children edition. Shakespeare wrote for production therefore students will practice and present scenes from the play as well as learn about the plot, characters and conflict of this classic English comedy.
